OAP Standing Rules

- 1. The OAP logo shall be used on official correspondence.
- 2. The official address of the Oregon Association of Parliamentarians shall be that of the current president.
- 3. All official correspondence concerning the IRS shall include the OAP TIN (Taxpayer Identification Number).
- 4. Units should use their own TIN when applying for a unit's bank account(s).
- 5. The OAP state publication shall be known as *The Oregon Agenda*.
- 6. NAP officers may attend any meeting of the OAP board of directors, education event(s) or annual meeting.
- 7. Officers shall be installed during the annual meeting, at which time the president shall be presented with an association president's pin.
- 8. An OAP Unit Kit, based on NAP material, to be paid for by OAP, shall be provided to each new group organizing a unit.
- 9. A new unit shall receive a gavel engraved with the unit's name, as an OAP gift. It shall be presented by the OAP president, with appropriate ceremony, to the unit after the unit charter is received.
